These flashcards can be easily printed from the Parent Portal, offering an additional resource to practice frequently missed words and accelerate literacy development.

For Canadian users, the introductory Mighty VIP rate is CAD \$199 annually or CAD \$19.95 monthly. The app is now available for both iPad and iPhone users in the Apple App Store.
